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# **Pool Renovation is Complete**

- New plaster on all the surface
- Coping and new tile around the perimeter
- Broken floor on entrance ramp was fixed and tile was replaced with plaster
- Mushroom was repainted

State Inspection has already been scheduled and, once approved, we will be ready to open for Memorial Day weekend!

Opening Day: May 24th at 9 AM

Please help us keep the area pool a safe and fun place for all neighbors; you can do this by rearranging the furniture and cleaning your area before you leave.

The pool hours are from 9 AM to 9 PM.

Please remember there are magnetic locks in the back door and the pool gate that will automatically lock at closing time; this means that if you are still in the pool area after closing time you won't be able to get out without assistance.

You will have to call the clubhouse phone number, leave a voicemail, and someone will contact you and assist with letting you out and you will be charged \$55. If the same household gets locked in a second time, their pool access will be suspended for the remainder of the season.
