About recreational vehicles and boats: Recreational and camping vehicles, trailers and boats may be stored and parked on the lots; however, these vehicles, trailers and boats shall be located behind the dwelling or the side lot of the dwelling but only if screened by a privacy fence which is at least 6 feet in height so that such vehicles, trailers, or boats will not be readily visible from any street or adjoining lot.
